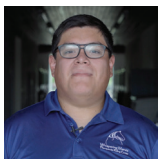

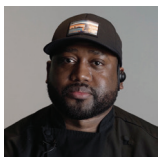

Our Services

Employment Services are designed to assist individuals with disabilities obtain and maintain competitive employment in the community with the guidance of an Employment Specialist.

Supported Employment Services assist individuals with significant disabilities obtain and maintain competitive, integrated employment.

Pre-Placement Training Class is the first step toward helping individuals navigate the essential requirements of employment.

Pre-Employment Transition Services work together with students, families, schools and community organizations to promote successful transitions from school.

Self Advocacy Training teaches you how to speak up for yourself and increase your confidence, independence, and self-empowerment.

On-The-Job Training (OTJ) is a mentorship opportunity for employers and job seekers. OTJ supports skill development and assists individuals with disabilities in gaining work experience. OTJ is managed by (VR) and receives federal-state funding.

Vocational Evaluation is the process of determining an individual's interests, abilities, aptitudes and skills to identify vocational strengths, needs and career potential.

Situational Evaluation, also known as a Work-Site Evaluation, involves the placing of a person in an actual work situation to assess their performance.

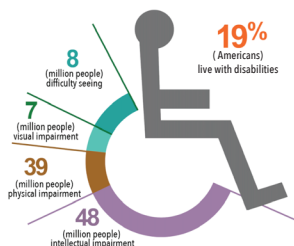
